

A recent inductee into the Greater Calumet Area USBC Hall of Fame has claimed the A Division title in the 8th Annual Senior Singles Tournament at Set 'em Up Lanes.

John Dudek, 59, of Orland Park, went out with a bang to claim the division title for bowlers 50-59 who average 211 or more. Dudek, a 2013 GCA USBC Hall of Fame inductee, rolled a 716 actual series (737 with handicap) to edge Jim Rutherford and Keith Betts, who tied with 714.

After turning 60, Dudek is expected to compete in the 2015 tournament in the C Division for bowlers 60 and older who average 211 or more.

All places are unofficial pending average verification.

In the C Division, Jerry Sabin, of Griffith, rolled a 674 series (716 with handicap) to claim the top spot. Following Sabin were Ken Pogach (710) and Greg Johns (698).

In Class B, Griffith's Chuck Marovich posted a 651 actual series and added 75 pins of handicap for 726. He led that division by more than 75 pins. His closest competitors were Carol Vargo, of Whiting, with 644 and Jeff Barnes, of Highland, with 641.

A Lynwood man claimed the D Division title for bowlers 60 and older who average 210 or less. William Higgins rolled a 660 series to top Marshall Surratt's 649 and Andy Hoke's 623.

The winners will be honored at the 28th Annual Greater Calumet Area USBC Hall of Fame and Awards banquet in December.
